Program

Develop, promote, and evaluate the Resident and Fellow Symposium for the annual meeting. Organize speakers and topics for future symposia.

Communications

Identify methods of informing residents of RSNA benefits and offerings while they are in the early stages of training. Encourage continued involvement with the RSNA as both trainee and attending. Develop and contribute resident-relevant topics for the monthly eNewsletter that is sent to nearly 200 RSNA Resident Representatives (R3) across the country who serve as a bridge between the RSNA and their respective institutions. Share information about the full range of services and resources RSNA has to offer with their fellow residents.

Radiographics

Collect and evaluate RG content suitable for the RSNA members in training. Committed to making educational materials available to members in training through RSNA. Recently implemented a new RG Panelist Reviewer program that allows a different resident to sit on each of the 27 RG review panels.

Medical Student Outreach

Increase medical student engagement and promote the field of radiology and the RSNA to medical students. Work to provide educational resources to medical students and educators, and to create opportunities for medical student collaboration with resident members.

Diversity and Inclusion

Assists the organization-wide Committee on Diversity & Inclusion. Identifies existing resources and strategies for R&F diversification, unconscious bias, and conflict resolution. Develops new resources to educate trainees that will enhance and support the overall mission of D&I as well as provide a forum of discussion on how diversity is being taught across the country.
