
UNIQUE IN THE REGION

- Only National Cancer Institute-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center for adults and children.
- Only Level I trauma center designated by the American College of Surgeons serving both adults and children in the region.
- Neonatal intensive care was pioneered at Vanderbilt. Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt is the only neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) in our region with the highest Level IV state and national rating, reflecting exceptional expertise in treating the most complex problems facing our tiniest patients, while leading research and training for neonatologists serving the nation.
- The only dedicated burn center serving adult and children in the state.
- Recognized by the National Association of Epilepsy Centers as the only Level 4 Epilepsy Center for adults in Tennessee. We are one of only two Level 4 Epilepsy Centers for children in the state.



TRANSPLANT ACHIEVEMENTS

- More heart transplants than any other program in the Southeast, and second in the U.S. First medical center in Tennessee to implant a total artificial heart.
- Largest kidney transplant program in Tennessee, performing an average of 200 procedures per year.
- Performed more than 450 lung transplants and 20 lung-heart transplants. Survival rates exceed nationally established benchmarks.
- The largest and pioneering liver program in the Mid-South, and the 12th largest in the U.S., having performed more than 2,150 transplants since the program's inception in 1991.
- One of the highest quality scores among U.S. stem cell transplant programs. One of the largest stem cell programs in the Southeast, with more than 275 stem cell transplants per year.
