VICC Catchment Area

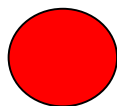
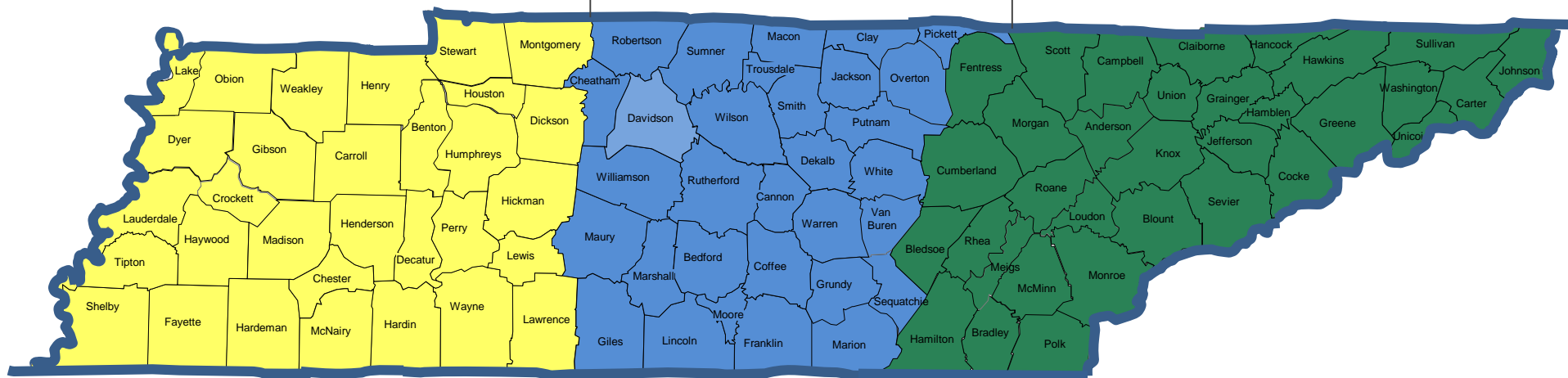




Western Region
