How is CDA for new faculty determined?

CDA allocations for initial faculty appointments are individually determined by the Chair and stated in the offer letter. All other things being equal, the typical CDA allocation for a new full-time CP track faculty member who has largely a clinical role is 22 days (ACC=199). The typical CDA allocation for a new full-time CE track faculty member who has academic aspirations is 42 days (ACC=179). CDA for new faculty are prorated based on start date. Additional role and responsibility expectations engender additional Administrative and/or Academic CDA. For each year thereafter, the faculty member must submit a CDA application. As a general rule, whenever possible, new faculty are given up to three years of stable or increasing CDA to allow them to develop their academic careers.
