






New Documentation Tools in eStar for SedLine and TOF
With the introduction of the SedLine devices, we have added patient state index (PSI) as a new data element next to BIS. This is available under 'Vitals/Agents' as the SedLine devices are not yet interfaced automatically into eStar.



We are also adding a TOF ratio documentation tool, which will be available through Vitals/Agents as well as the anesthesia grid. The TOF ratio will be automatically imported from the Philips monitor.



eStar: Blood Product Administration Handoff
In the rare situation where blood is actively being administered upon transfer out of intra-op, the receiving nurse will document an action of "handoff" in the blood product administration window. There is a requirement of a dual sign for this. The anesthesia provider handing off the patient to the nurse will need to enter their username and password to sign as a second sign for the handoff. eStar: Update on OB Epidural Documentation
As of Wednesday, Aug. 12, we implemented three changes for OB anesthesia:
- The 'Pre' column in the anesthesia greaseboards will now function correctly for pre-ops older than 3 days.
- A new 'Last Assess' column has been added to the greaseboards, which shows the number of minutes since the last OB assessment.
- The COVID testing column for the 'OB Follow-Up' status board now displays correctly for labor analgesia records.

COVID-19 Literature Search
Many faculty have expressed interest in easy access to the latest and best scientific evidence about COVID-19. The CLARITY program has developed a custom PubMed search designed to capture most of the anesthesia professional relevant evidence-based literature on COVID-19 appearing in the highest-impact general and anesthesia journals. To see our most recent weekly selections (9 entries chosen from 14 search results received on 8-12-20), use this link: Display the 9 citations in PubMed. A quick read of the titles and the abstracts (click on paper title) will help you determine which articles you might like to read. To read the full text of a paper, you may need to log in to PubMed using your VUNetID and Password. To log in initially, follow these steps:

- Click on the link provided above to see this week's article list in PubMed.
Select "Log In" (top right corner of screen).
Select "other log in options."
Search Vanderbilt on the next screen or scroll down to click on Vanderbilt University and enter your VUNetID and password.

You are now logged in to PubMed. By logging in this way, you have our search selections list available to scroll through (navigating left to right), and you can access full text for each article via the library subscriptions. Note also that "similar articles" are displayed beneath each article in the list.


