Grant Submission Guidelines

The Departmental Grants Process Policy has been updated and revised. Most timelines for submitting budgets and other grant materials are unchanged.

Requirements for submitting Mentored Research Grants (FAER, IARS, K awards, etc) that require a significant departmental cost share must be submitted 90 days in advance for review by the Anesthesiology Research Executive Committee.

New VPIMS web servers used for Peri-Procedural Applications

As of Sunday Jan. 20, 2019, applications associated with VPIMS (SAGA, Integrated Presence, eORBoard, LivRBoard, FPPE, TissueTracking, VideoBoard, Break Tracker, VPIMS Web) have been migrated to a new server.

Associated URLs (links) within the CWS and Integrated EPIC environments have been updated to use the new links. What this will not update is all the AWS workstations that may have custom shortcuts or bookmarks. Even with the personal shortcuts and bookmarks, our current servers should forward "most" of them to the new links with no user interaction. That being said, we want to make sure the users have the correct links in case they have bookmarks to pages we don't have forwarded. **Please note that these applications can only be launched from within the VUMC network. If you are offsite or mobile, you will need to use the VPN to use these websites/applications.**
