Attention Faculty: AAA Error

An error in a formula within the AAA spreadsheet has been brought to our attention. In the Major Publications tab, entering an Impact Factor of "L" ("Lower") yields a score of 120 (1st author), 100 (2nd or Senior author), or 70 (other author). This is an error in the formula, as a Lower Impact Factor ("L") should yield a score of 180 (1st author), 150 (2nd or Senior author), or 105 (other author).

When you return your completed spreadsheet to me, I will be making this correction in the formula.




