We will do our part to prevent infection. And we need you to do your part, too.

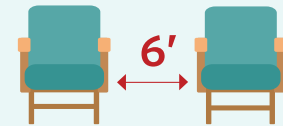
What we will do



- Wear masks at all times.
- Screen our staff for COVID-19 at every entrance.



- Sanitize exam rooms after each visit.
- Clean public areas many times a day.



Make sure that all public areas allow people to stay 6 feet apart.

What we will ask you to do when you visit



- Wear face masks.
- Be screened for COVID-19 whenever you enter our building.



When you're not at one of our facilities

Stay at home if you can. If you must go out, follow these guidelines.



Clean surfaces often.



Don't spend too much time in public.



Wear a face mask in public.



- Keep 6 feet of distance (2 grocery carts) away from others.
- Only go to businesses that keep people 6 feet apart and whose employees wear masks.



Don't touch your face or mask.



- Wash hands often.
- You can also use a hand sanitizer with 60–90% alcohol.
