Wear your mask correctly.

All people must wear a mask while on Vanderbilt University Medical Center campus.

- Masks are required in cafeterias, food courts, break rooms, research labs, conference rooms, bathrooms, elevators, waiting rooms—everywhere.
- Masks should be worn while walking outdoors to and from VUMC buildings and from parking areas—starting from the time you get out of your car.
- Masks may be removed **only** if you are at your assigned workspace (for example: office, cubicle, lab bench, desk)
 and can maintain at least 6 feet of distance from all others.
- Masks may be removed to eat or drink only if you can maintain 6 feet of distance from others and stay in place.
