These summer positions are for undergraduate or graduate students, physicians or veterinarians with an interest in a career in biomedical informatics. Summer Research Experience training positions are funded by the National Library of Medicine (NLM/NIH).

General Prerequisites:

- Be 18 years of age on or before the first day of the internship
- A GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- A background in programming and a moderate understanding of using computer technology is an advantage. The specific prerequisites for a research project will be addressed by the faculty mentor
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

The application package must include:

- Complete application form with signature (handwritten forms will not be accepted)
- Updated CV
- Transcripts from current institution (unofficial copy is acceptable; must include student's information)
- Two letters of recommendation; can be sent via e-mail (rischelle.jenkins@vanderbilt.edu)
- One letter of good standing from current institution

Internship positions/appointments are considered full-time (40 hours per week). In order to be considered for an interview, all applicants must submit a completed application and all required documents.
