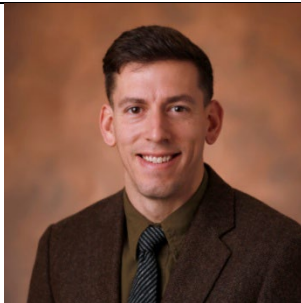
Dr. Nichols co- precepts the Inflammatory Conditions (IBD) rotation.
