Hospital Pharmacy Practice:

Residents will gain experience working in the central pharmacy and as a decentralized clinical pharmacist. PGY-1 residents staff in the central pharmacy every third weekend from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm. They also staff from 4:00pm-8:00pm every sixth weekday. The evening staffing component is in central pharmacy July-December and is decentralized January-June.

Code Response:

The residents participate in code coverage all year round except during the orientation period of June and July. There is a rotating schedule of code coverage that is evenly distributed among the residents. The resident covers any stat calls from 07:00 am to 15:00 pm on their allocated days.

Therapeutic Exchange:

The therapeutic exchange is the 1 hour continuing education presentation that the resident presents to the pharmacy department. The resident will present their presentation at two different one-hour sessions.

InPharmation:

InPharmation is the pharmacy newsletter and published every other month. Each resident will coordinate the writing and assembly of the newsletter once during the residency year.

Teaching Certificate (optional):

Residents are able to complete a teaching certificate through Belmont College of Pharmacy or Lipscomb College of Pharmacy.
