Planview Enterprise One Upgrade Coming Soon

VUMC is in the process of upgrading Planview Enterprise One, scheduled to go live in July. Here are some highlights of changes coming with version 18:

- Enhanced Resource Management and Assignments screen layout and functions, including click-and-drag substitutions, alphabetical listings of resources within a portfolio, and improved action menus
- New Aggregator functions in Resource Management screens for quick overviews of team assignment data
- Enhanced Column Set viewing options, including ability to show/hide columns in Work and Resource screens
- New Action Menu options on Work and Assignments screen allow status updates to multiple line items at once
- Configured screens redesigned with a new modern look and feel for improved usability

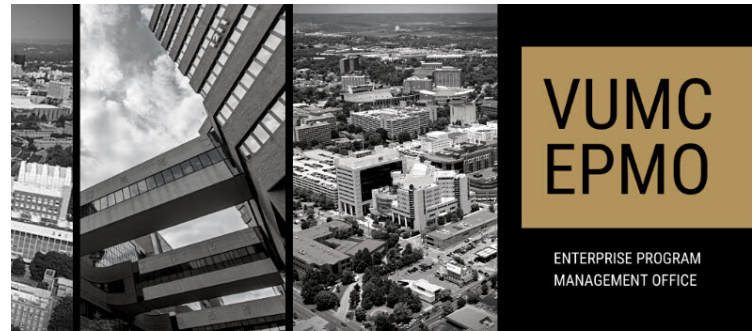
