**Field Experience: Optional but highly recommended and can satisfy up to 6 of the 9 additional elective coursework credit hours.**

Students meet with certificate program faculty/staff to develop an appropriate practicum experience. A final written report (10-12 pages, double-spaced) is required in order to receive credit for the Field Experience.

- Six weeks' participation in a Global Health practicum, internship, or clinical rotation, with a final product. This can be fulfilled by other graduate and professional school requirements, such as the Peabody IEPM Practicum.
- Three- to six-month VUSM Research Immersion
- Full-year (10-12 months) Global Health-related program in a low-resource setting with a final product:
