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TRAINING PROGRAM REDUCTION/CLOSURE OR LOSS OF ACCREDITATION POLICY

VUMC will inform the GMEC, DIO, and affected House Staff as soon as possible if it intends to reduce the size of or close one or more ACGME-accredited programs, or if VUMC were to intend to close.

House Staff in an affected program(s) will be allowed to complete their education at VUMC, or the GME office will assist them in enrolling in (an)other program(s) in which they can continue their education.

If VUMC or major participating site that is a hospital loses its accreditation for patient care, VUMC will notify and provide a plan of response to the Institutional Review Committee (IRC) of the ACGME within 30 days.

Similarly, if VUMC or a participating site's license is denied suspended, or revoked, or if VUMC or a participating site has activities curtailed or otherwise restricted, VUMC will notify and provide a plan for its response to the IRC of the ACGME within 30 days.
