



States' Proposed and Implemented 1115 Medicaid Waiver Programs

There are currently seven states that operate Section 1115 Medicaid waiver programs to expand coverage to eligible individuals under 138% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). Kentucky submitted an application to CMS in August 2016 to change their traditional Medicaid expansion to an 1115 Medicaid waiver program. The application is still being reviewed by CMS, but is included in the table below.
