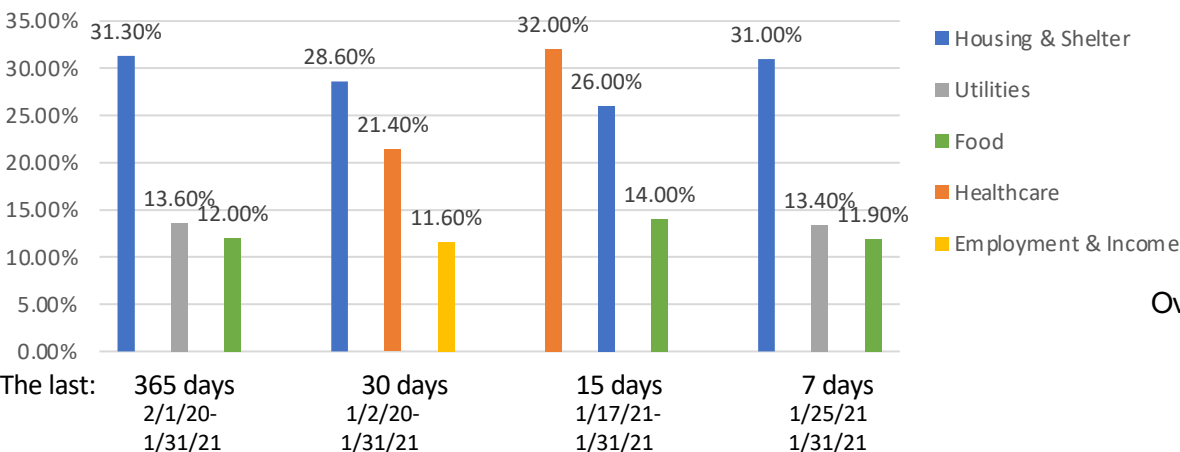


# Emerging Needs in Cheatham & Robertson Counties

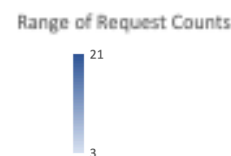
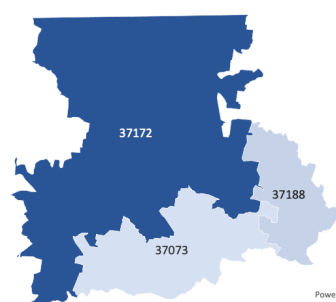
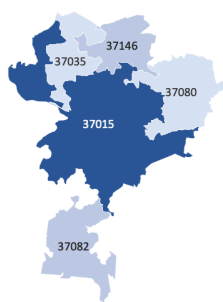

## Range of Requests by Zip Code in the last 30 days

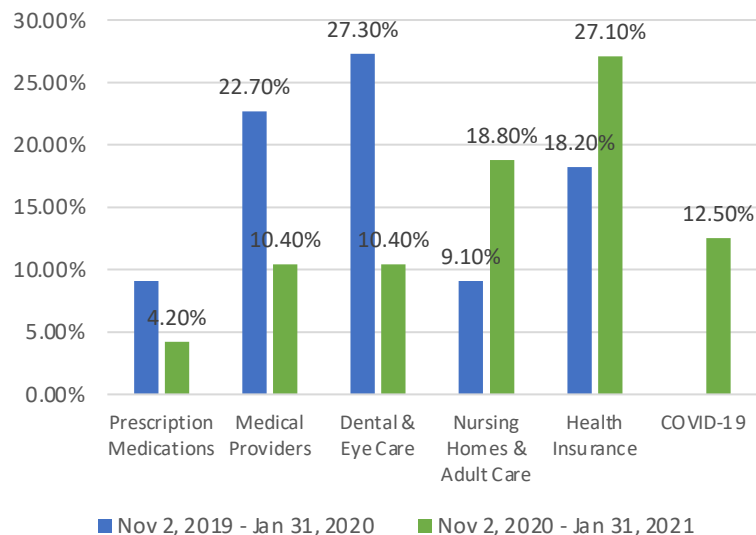

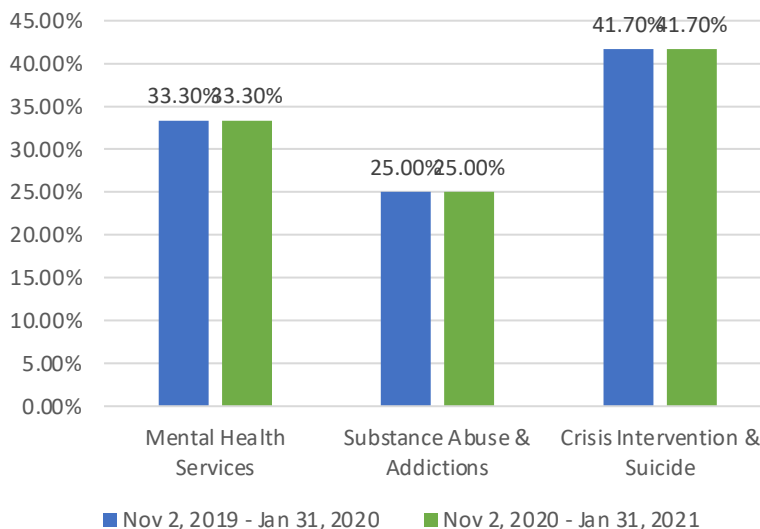

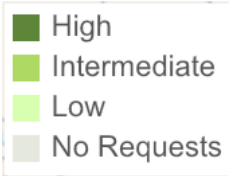


# Emerging Needs in Cheatham & Robertson Counties

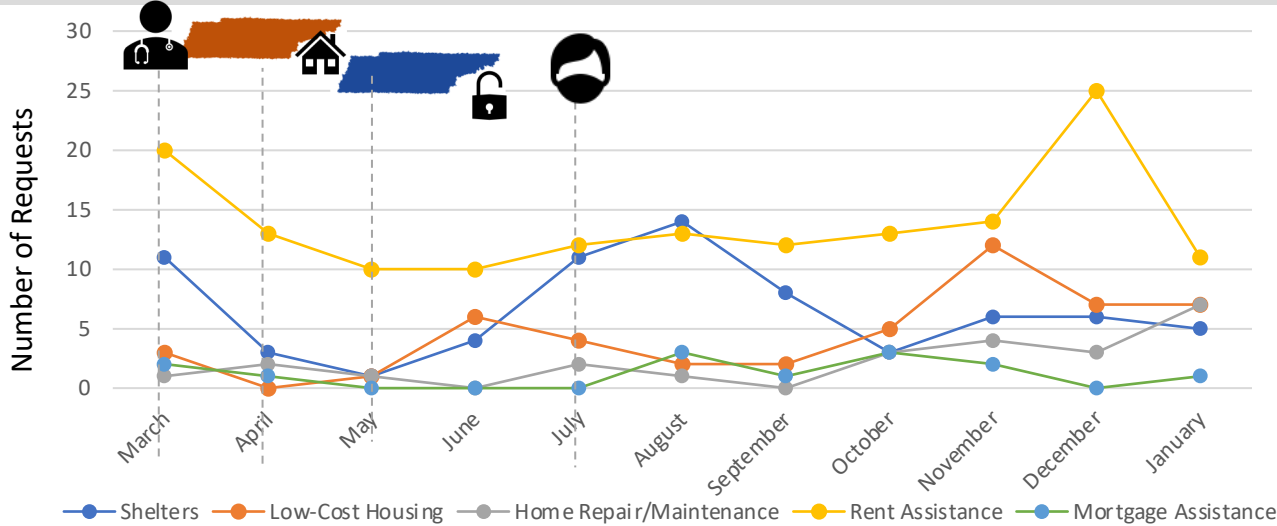

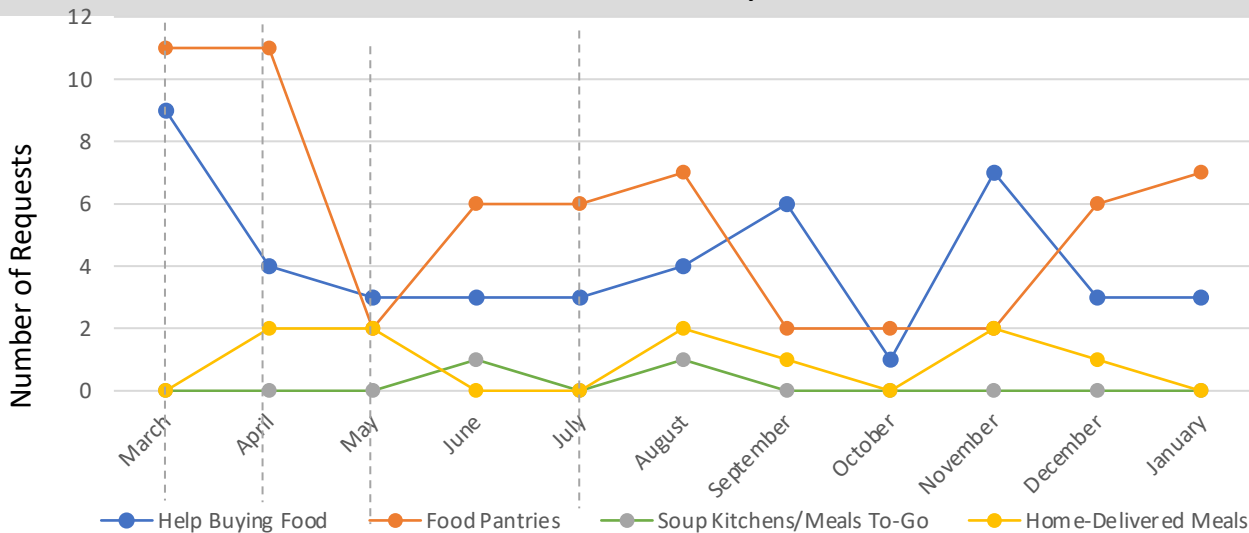

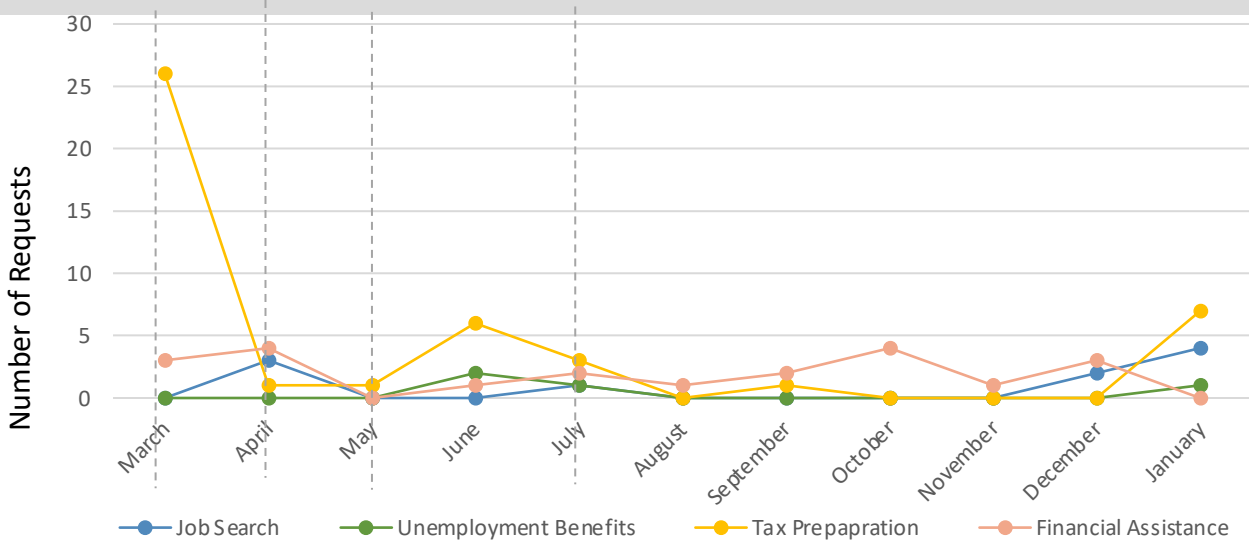
