



Who may participate?

All participants must live in the same home.

- Your child who is already enrolled in your local study
- A parent
- A second caregiver
- Another child (to age 21)

Everything will be done in your home.

You will be compensated up to \$420 or more for participating

1 **Review and complete the Information Sheet**

Complete by clicking the link and agree to participate, or you can ask for a study staff member to review with you over the phone.

2 **Complete the Baseline Survey and Specimen Collections**

- This is a one-time survey and will be the longest survey of the study. It asks basic information about everyone in your family enrolled in the HEROS study.
- Collect samples on everyone enrolled in the HEROS study using the kits that will be sent to your home (via FedEx).
 - Nose sample using a swab (like a Q-tip)
 - Stool (poop) sample using a swab
 - A blood sample using an automatic, nearly painless collection device (only those over 2 years of age)

3 **Every 2 weeks for 18 weeks (9 times), you will:**

- Complete a short survey.
- Collect nose samples using a swab (like a Q-tip).

4 **Each week, you will receive a text or email to ask if anyone in your family is sick.**

If anyone becomes sick you will be asked to:

- Complete a brief survey about the sick person's symptoms.
- Collect a nose sample and stool sample using a swab from everyone in your family participating in the HEROS study.
- Three weeks later, collect a blood sample from everyone in your family participating in the HEROS study using a nearly painless self-collection device placed on your skin.

5 **At 4.5 months and 6 months, you will:**

- Collect a blood sample from everyone in your family participating in the HEROS study using an automatic, nearly painless collection device placed on your skin (only those over age 2 years) (4.5 months and 6 months).
- Complete an end-of-study survey (6 months only).
