WHAT is it?

Migrate all applications and related components (i.e., servers, databases, security groups, resource accounts, file shares) from all VU shared directories **to** the new **VUMC vumc.io directory**.

WHY are we doing it?

- End VUMC use of the VU shared directories
- Streamline workforce member experience and application access
- Improve VUMC security posture via modern access methods
- Improve access security by removing legacy VU shared directory artifacts like "nested groups"

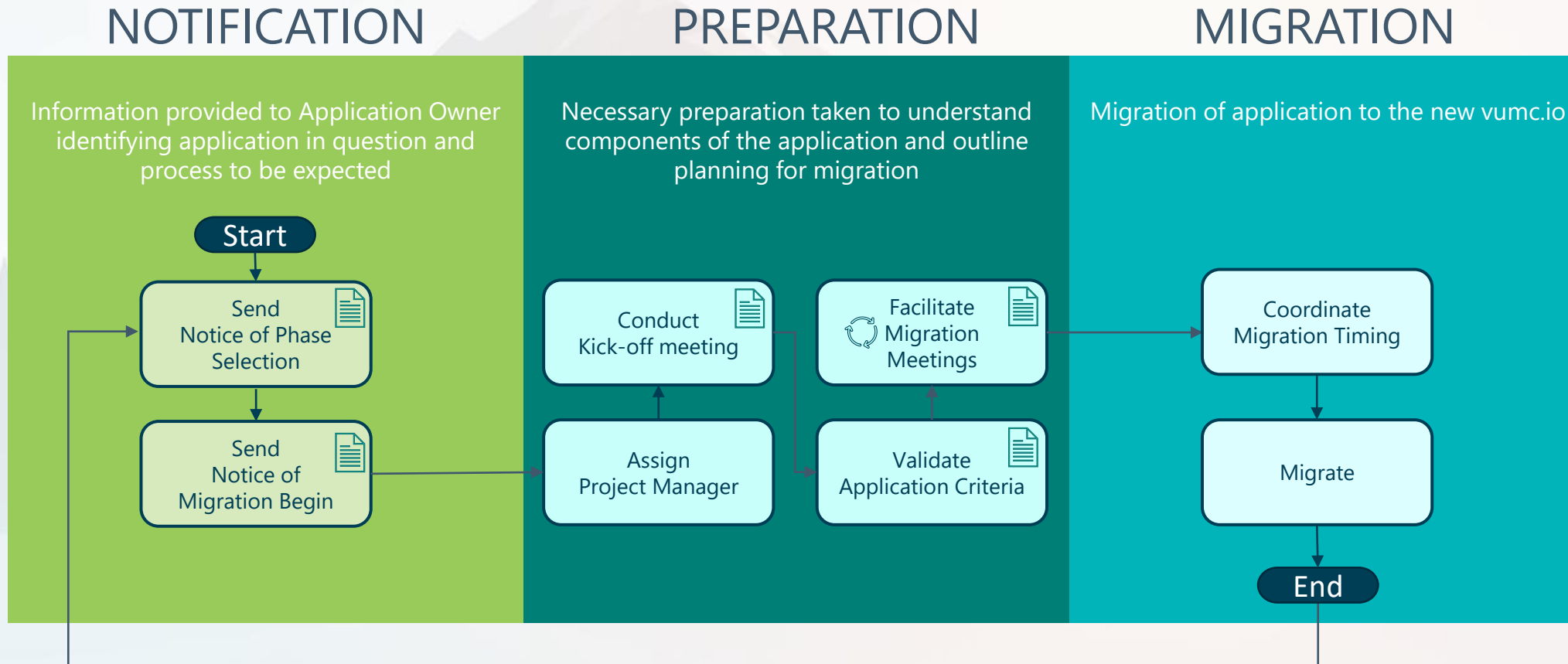
If you do NOT find your application on this lookup tool, your app is either:

Application Migration Process

Application Migration Criteria



Process initiated for each individual application

- Results of survey results and Inventory
- Level of vendor involvement (if applicable)
- Authentication Method
- Pegasus CI's
- Number of server(s) involved
- Group Management
- Potential Blockers
