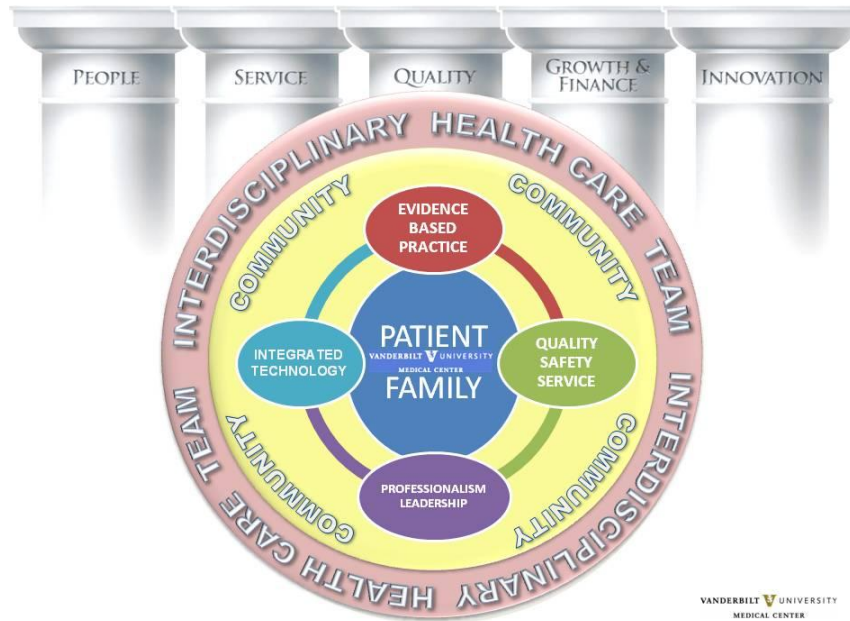


Vanderbilt’s Professional Practice Model (PPM) – Summary

- PPM is based on patient/family centered care and drives the care delivery system for all disciplines
- Tim Porter O’Grady’s model of shared decision-making (shared governance) is the piece for self-regulation
- Benner’s Novice to Expert Theory (VPNPP) guides the development of the professional nurse
- Virginia Henderson’s Theory supports the role of the professional nurse as a unique, integral member of the interdisciplinary team with a unique knowledgebase and skill set
