What is the TRITON research study?



Your doctor is currently enrolling participants with glaucoma or high eye pressure in a research study called TRITON

- A prescription, branded eye pressure-lowering medication in an investigational delivery system is being studied
- There is no placebo in this research study—all participants will receive study medication
- The research study is approximately 32 months long

To qualify for the TRITON research study, you must:

- Have glaucoma or high eye pressure
- Be at least 18 years old
- Have not had surgery for your glaucoma

What will I receive if I qualify and enroll in the TRITON research study?



During the study, you will receive study-related eye exams and the study medication at no cost

- Study-related doctor visits will provide you with eye exams and check to see if the study medication is working
- The study medication will be provided throughout the research study

You may also receive additional compensation

- Your time and necessary travel to study visits may be covered
- Your time is valuable and we would like to thank you for your participation in researching the future of glaucoma therapy
