

Thank you for your interest in the Vanderbilt Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Residency Program at Vanderbilt University Medical Center.

TRACKS OFFERED

Vanderbilt offers both a six- and four-year track in oral and maxillofacial surgery training, as well as externship opportunities. The Vanderbilt program is accredited by the Council on Dental Accreditation and successful completion of the residency satisfies the educational requirements for certification by the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. The volume of cases far exceeds accreditation standard requirements.

TYPES OF OPERATIONS AND PROCEDURES

The OMS residency provides our trainees with increasing responsibility in patient management consistent with excellent patient care and safety. Residents will receive training in the comprehensive management of hard and soft tissue facial trauma and acquired and developmental deformities of the facial skeleton. In addition to an in depth experience in:

- orthognathic surgery
- · management of obstructive sleep apnea
- dentoalveolar surgery
- secondary alveolar cleft repair
- management of temporomandibular joint disease
- functional and esthetic bone graft reconstruction of the jaws and facial skeletal defects
- osseointegrated implants
- · management of head and neck infections
- benign neoplasms and cysts of the oral and maxillofacial region

PROGRAM SUPPORT

The program is supported by a comprehensive core didactic curriculum. The core curriculum consists of weekly didactic lectures, seminars, workshops, anatomy dissection, and a core reading list. The Vanderbilt program has allocated a four-hour block every week, protected from clinical activities or other distractions. to devote to didactic activities. The core curriculum is enhanced with the participation by prominent local and national speakers. Residents are provided a generous assortment of textbooks during the course of the residency. First-year trainees attend a variety of national meetings and continuing education programs supported by the department. Resident participation in scholarly activities such as clinical research and manuscript preparation are promoted and fully supported by the department.

EXTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Externships are offered to third-year dental students who are interested in a brief but concentrated exposure to the specialty of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. The duration of the Externship is one-to-two weeks. The dental student extern will participate in all departmental activities, both clinical and didactic. Also, the extern will be encouraged to take in-house maxillofacial trauma call with the OMS residents.


