Effective Date: June 21st, 2023

## MIDL Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Congenital CMV Infection (LAB 1332)

Effective June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023, VUMC Diagnostic Laboratories will now accept infant urine as a specimen source in addition to infant saliva.

**Test Ordering:** MIDL PCR CMV QI (CMD), LAB1332. Separate orders are needed if testing infant saliva or urine.

**Specimen Collection:** Collect infant urine into a sterile container.

**Results Reporting:** Results will be reported as NOT DETECTED OR DETECTED. eStar results will be visible in the same location as infant saliva results (Microbiology -> Virology).
