POLICY

The construction manager/contractor is responsible for the enforcement of the dress requirements as outlined in the "Article 3-Special Provisions" section of the PLANNING | DESIGN | CONSTRUCTION (PDC) Contractor's Safety Program. The Construction Manager/contractor is also responsible to ensure that all construction workers associated with the Construction Manager/contractor's projects dress appropriately so as to not offend other people.

PROCEDURE

To convey a professional appearance to patients, visitors, and co-workers.

I. Specific Information

- A. The following apparel is considered inappropriate:
 - i. Sleeveless tee shirts
 - ii. Excessively ripped clothing
 - iii. Shorts
 - iv. Open toe shoes
 - v. Any apparel with inappropriate gestures, sayings, logos
