I. Purpose:

To define the Vanderbilt University Medical Center (VUMC) PLANNING | DESIGN | CONSTRUCTION policy on smoking for all persons working on VUMC construction sites.

II. Policy:

In accordance with the Vanderbilt University Medical Center Smoking Policy (SA 40-10.02), smoking is prohibited in all VUMC facilities and campus except in specific designated outside locations.

III. Designated Locations:

- A. The designated locations for smoking are:
 - i. East Parking Garage Ramp (outside garage, located along 21st Ave)
 - ii. Corner of Children's Way and Medical Center Drive (inside fenced in area)
- B. Smoking outside of approved areas
 - i. Subject to Smoke Patrol enforcement
 - ii. Subject to removal from campus
