


Inpatient Provider/Nursing: Ordering Source Patients Labs


If you have an exposure to Blood and Body fluids (BBF), you will want to collect a specimen from the Source patient. This will help to determine if anti-retroviral post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) is necessary.

Steps To Follow


1. Open your **Source Patient's** chart in the **Current Encounter**.
2. Open your **Orders** activity.




3. Type **"Source Patient"** to find the order set for BBF exposures.




4. Select the Source Blood/Body Fluid Exposure Panel




5. Click **Accept**.
6. Fill in the Order Composer with requested details (be sure to address the Wildcards in the box).
7. Click **Accept**.



8. Verify the Order set in the right side pane. It should include **Patient Education, How to notify a Provider of the results, Rapid HIV BBF Exposure, Hepatitis B Surface Ag, and PCR Hepatitis C Virus Qt.**
9. Sign: **Order**
 - a. Nursing:
 - Order Mode: Verbal with Readback



10. Verify the Orders are in your patient's chart.



11. Collect the specimens and send to the lab as usual.
