

## Inpatient Provider/Nursing: Ordering Source Patients Labs

If you have an exposure to Blood and Body fluids (BBF), you will want to collect a specimen from the Source patient. This will help to determine if anti-retroviral post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) is necessary.

## Steps To Follow

- 1. Open your Source Patient's chart in the Current Encounter.
- 2. Open your Orders activity.



3. Type "Source Patient" to find the order set for BBF exposures.
