*Research time in PGY-3 is flexible based on resident research need. If a resident would prefer more research time in PGY-4, then 60% could be allocated in PGY-4 and 40% allocated in PGY-3 for research. Allocating 50% research time both in PGY-3 and PGY-4 ensures residents are eligible to apply for the NIH Loan Repayment Program in PGY-2.
