² The resident may be asked to fill gaps in coverage left by residents on vacation.

³ One block of inpatient medicine may be substituted for inpatient pediatrics

⁴ About 5% of these rotations are reserved for a 6 month longitudinal psychotherapy clinic.

⁵ Elective rotations can consist of any clinical, quality improvement, research, or combined experiences. They can occur across any clinical setting in any proportion.
