She completed her radiology residency at Mount Sinai West, and dual fellowships in Body Imaging at Stanford University, and the nationally-selected Informatics fellowship through the American College of Radiology (ACR).

Dr. Doo's expertise and publication record spans the domains of clinical radiology (body/abdominal imaging), artificial intelligence (AI)/informatics, health equity, and business/entrepreneurship.
