## Nasir Malim, DO, MPH

Academic Hospitalist, Division of Hospital Medicine, Mount Sinai Morningside

Nasir Malim began his academic pursuits in the intersection between health and systems of inequity during his bachelor's degree in African American Studies at the University of California-Irvine.



He then pursued an MPH with a focus on urban health disparities at Charles R. Drew University in Los Angeles and medical school at Touro College of Osteopathic Medicine-Middletown. It was during this time he implemented the Social Medicine Curriculum nationally across dozens of osteopathic medical schools throughout the country in order to further contextualize the social and historical factors affecting the health of communities and individuals.

He then pursued residency training at Montefiore Medical Center in the Bronx in Primary Care and Social Internal Medicine.

Currently he is part of the teaching faculty in the department of Hospital Medicine at Mount Sinai Morningside in Manhattan.
