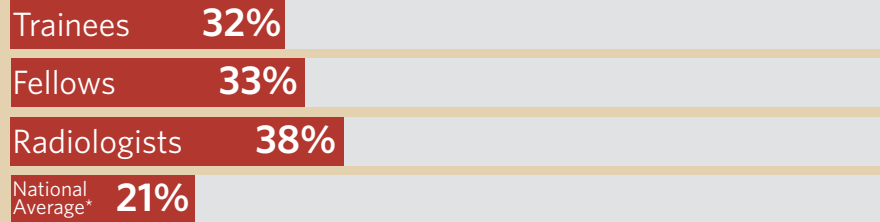

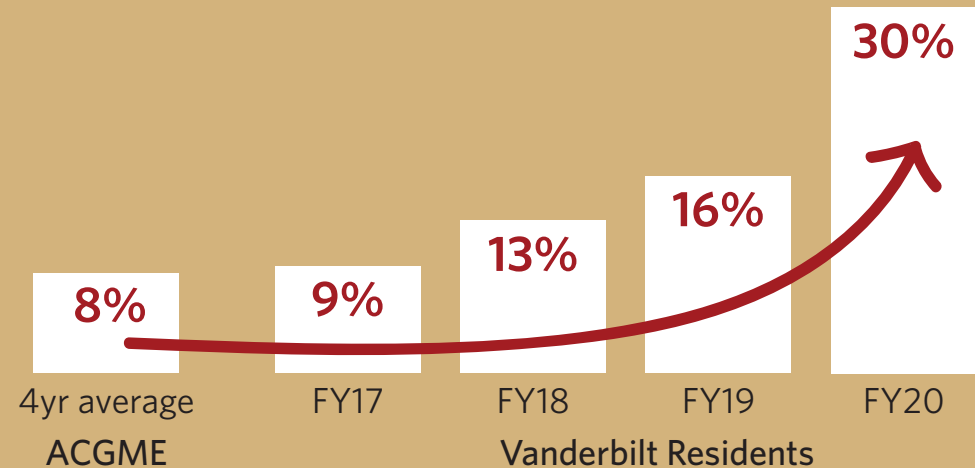


WOMEN IN LEADERSHIP
