ADULT ACUTE CARE CLINICAL OPPORTUNITIES

All SPT/SPTAs completing a clinical rotation in adult acute care at Vanderbilt University Hospital will be matched with a CI to complete their instructional time. SPT/SPTAs will maintain the daily schedule of their CI, managing either a primary service-line or floating throughout the hospital. Although not an all-inclusive list, the numerous opportunities afforded from a clinical rotation at VUMC are listed below.

- Experience interdisciplinary coordination of care between medical team members such as MD/DO (primary and consult teams with/without medical residents), NP, PA, RT, RN, CNA, OT, SLP, EMT, PharmD, RD, Case Manager, Social Work, Child Life Specialist, Chaplain, hospital volunteer
- Observe other rehabilitation team members such as Occupational Therapy and/or Speech Language Pathology
- Perform evaluations and/or treatments with associated documentation according to the requirements and guidelines provided by the APTA CPI assessment tool
- Acute VUH Rotations may experience the following areas:
 - o Burn Unit
 - CVICU (Cardiovascular Intensive Care Unit) and Cardiology/Cardio-Thoracic Surgery
 - General Medicine
 - MICU (Medical Intensive Care Unit)
 - Myelosuppression/Oncology Unit
 - Neurology and Neurosurgery with NICU (Neuro Intensive Care Unit)
 - Post-Surgical Step-Down Units
 - Renal/Dialysis Unit
 - SICU (Surgical Intensive Care Unit)

- Acute MCN Rotations may experience the following areas:
 - General Medicine
 - Geriatrics
 - Orthopaedics
 - Palliative Medicine
 - o Post-Surgical Step-Down Units
- Opportunities to evaluate and treat patients with the following disorders (not all-inclusive):
 - Amputations
 - Burns
 - o CABG/MI
 - Cancer
 - COPD/Emphysema

- o Multiple Sclerosis/Guillain-Barre, AIDP/CIDP
- o Orthopaedic Trauma
