

Evaluating the Long-Term Outcomes from a Multidisciplinary Perspective of Patients that Underwent In-utero Repair of Myelomeningocele

- The purpose of this study is to evaluate the long-term outcomes from a multidisciplinary perspective of patients that underwent *in utero* repair of myelomeningocele.

Specific Aim 1: Evaluate long term urologic function and the need for additional surgical intervention in patients undergoing in utero myelomeningocele closures.

Specific Aim 2: Assess long term tethered cord and Chiari related symptoms and the need for neurosurgical intervention in patients undergoing in utero myelomeningocele closures.

Specific Aim 3: Determine long term mobility outcomes, including walking independently, walking with orthotics and no ambulation, in patients undergoing in utero myelomeningocele closures.
