



All incoming students are required to have **State of Tennessee** and **Vanderbilt University** mandated vaccinations & TB Screening before attending classes on campus. **As such, Vanderbilt University holds class registration until these requirements are met.**

State of TN & Vanderbilt University Required Immunization for Undergraduate and Graduate/Professional Students–

***Registration will be held if not compliant**

***M.M.R. (MEASLES, MUMPS, RUBELLA)- 2 doses required:**

Dose #1 given at age 12 months or later / Dose #2 given at least 28 days after first dose

-If vaccination records are not available, we will also accept official titer results showing positive IgG immunity.

-You are exempt from the M.M.R. vaccinations if born prior to 1956.

***VARICELLA - 2 doses required:**

Dose #1 given at age 12 months or later and after 1995/ Dose #2 given at least 28 days after first dose and after 1995

-We will also accept official titer results showing positive IgG immunity

-We will also accept History of the Disease (Chicken Pox) for domestic/non-international students. If you had the disease, provide a written statement from a parent or provider including student full name and the month and year of the disease. We will also accept if documented on a medical record.

-You are exempt from the varicella vaccine and requirements if born prior to 1980.

***MENINGOCOCCAL- A, C, Y, W type (for bacterial meningitis)**

Vaccine must be administered after **age 16** - You are exempt from this requirement if you are **NOT** living on campus (most graduate, medical and nursing students).

-The Meningococcal B vaccine is not required for Vanderbilt Undergraduate Students.

You may be required to submit blood test or skin test information depending on your risk factors.

Recommended Optional Reporting Vaccinations (registration will NOT be held)

COVID-19 (when available), Hepatitis A (2 doses), Hepatitis B (3 doses), HPV (3 doses), Meningococcal B (2 doses), Polio Series, Tdap (Adolescent or more recent), Tdap
