

State of TN & Vanderbilt University Required Immunizations

Registration will be held by the URO if not compliant

***COVID-19- 2 doses required for all, with the exception of J&J as 1 dose:**

Acceptable vaccines include AstraZeneca/Covishield/Vaxzevria, Janssen (Johnson & Johnson), Moderna, Pfizer-BioNTech, Sinopharm, Sinovac/CoronaVac.

(All Students required to submit documentation to Vanderbilt University COVID-19 Submission Portal located on this page: <https://www.vanderbilt.edu/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccine-information/>). Students *may also* submit to the Student Health Center Portal for continuity of care while on campus.

***M.M.R. (MEASLES, MUMPS, RUBELLA)- 2 doses required for All Students or positive titer report:**

Dose #1 given at age 12 months or later / Dose #2 given at least 28 days after first dose

-If vaccination records are not available, we will also accept official titer results showing positive IgG immunity.

-You are exempt from the M.M.R. vaccinations if born prior to 1956.

(All Students required to submit documentation to Student Health Center Portal. Nursing Students will also need to submit to the School of Nursing Castlebranch Portal)

***VARICELLA - 2 doses required for All Students or positive titer report:**

Dose #1 given at age 12 months or later and after 1995/ Dose #2 given at least 28 days after first dose and after 1995

-We will also accept official titer results showing positive IgG immunity

-We will also accept History of the Disease (Chicken Pox) for domestic/non-international students. If you had the disease, provide a written statement from a parent or provider including student full name and the month and year of the disease. We will also accept if documented on a medical record.

-You are exempt from the varicella vaccine and requirements if born prior to 1980.

(All Students required to submit documentation to Student Health Center Portal. Nursing Students will also need to submit to the School of Nursing Castlebranch Portal)

***MENINGOCOCCAL- A, C, Y, W type (for bacterial meningitis)-**

Vaccine must be administered after **age 16** - You are exempt from this requirement if you are **NOT** living on campus (most graduate, medical and nursing students). **(UGRD Students required to submit documentation to SHC Portal)**

***TB Screening Survey- Please complete the TB screening survey- only applicable for UGRD and GRAD/PROF. students:**

You can access at <https://redcap.vanderbilt.edu/surveys/?s=TFLTRT4THC>. Take the survey and send the SHC your survey results page. You may be required to submit blood test or skin test information depending on your risk factors and the testing will be required during the program year. **(UGRD & GRAD/PROF Students required to submit either the "No Testing Required Page" or signed "Testing Required Page" to SHC Portal)**

Clinical Programs for Medical and Nursing Students have additional required immunizations:

-3 Hepatitis B vaccinations (or a reactive titer)

-TDAP vaccination within the past 10 years

-TB testing. Skin tests must be within 1 year of the program start for School of Nursing and a 2nd PPD within 3 months is required for Medical Students. TB blood tests must be within 3 months of the program start date.

Clinical Students should review forms located on <https://vumc.org/student-health/immunization-requirements> when available for the program term.

Optional Reporting Vaccinations (registration will NOT be held by the URO)

Hepatitis A (2 doses), Hepatitis B (3 doses), HPV (3 doses), Influenza, Meningococcal B (2 doses), Polio Series, Tdap (Adolescent or more recent), Tdap. Student Health will document official records of these vaccines as part of your VUMC Medical Record.
