Vanderbilt Psychiatric Hospital Student Nurse Scope of Practice

Vanderbilt University Medical Center through Vanderbilt Psychiatric Hospital (VPH) provides an opportunity for clinical rotations during a credited course through nursing schools. Participants will work either in a group rotation with a Clinical Instructor or one-on-one with a VUMC preceptor. Clinical Instructors and Preceptors should give feedback regarding the student's progress and review all nursing tasks during the shift. While under the supervision of a Clinical Instructor or an assigned preceptor, the following is a non-inclusive scope of practice:
