Member Spotlight: Sunil Kripalani, MD, MSc



Sunil Kripalani, MD, MSc, SFHM, FACP, is a Professor of Medicine at VUMC, and Director of the <u>Center</u> for Health Services Research and <u>Center for Clinical Quality and Implementation Research</u>. His research interests include transitions of care, social determinants of health, health communication, and implementation science.

What I'm working on:

The main projects I'm working on right now are:

- 1. Clinical decision support to improve emergency department disposition for patients with heart failure (STRATIFY)
- 2. Development of a health equity dashboard for hospitals and health systems
- 3. A quality improvement collaborative for COVID-19 prevention and control in middle Tennessee nursing homes

VCLIC involvement:

I have always enjoyed working with colleagues in clinical informatics to improve EHR tools for documentation and decision support, especially for adult hospital care, which is my clinical area. Currently, we're working together on the STRATIFY study, will evaluate the effectiveness and implementation of a clinical decision support tool for emergency physicians to guide admission/discharge decisions for patients with heart failure.
