9:05am	Kaitlin Phillips	LMS Interface: book offs for 2-day courses	Service	 S: 2-day courses that have different class times each day (ex: PALS day 1 0800-1600, day 2 0800-1200) are no longer able to be automatically booked off as ISV shifts on employee schedules in VandyWorks. B: Due to a recent LMS update, multi-day courses are no longer able to be defined with individual day start/end times. A: 1-day courses and 2-day courses that have the same class times each day (ex: CCRN is 0800-1600 both days), will continue to book off via the LMS/VandyWorks interface effectively. PALS and ACLS 2-day courses are most commonly self-enrolled by employees. R: Upon enrollment in PALS or ACLS in LMS, employees should enter a Leave Request for ISV time in VandyWorks so that time can be approved by their leader and visible on the VandyWorks schedule. Employees should only submit time off in one system Approved hours (including unplanned book offs) are sent to Workday overnight and posted to Kronos timecard for nonexempt See VandyWorks Time Code list for which codes are sent to Workday Future-dated approved time off is not reflected in Kronos until that pay period VandyWorks receives updated flexPTO and Sick Time balances from Workday weekly FMLA tracking is all done within Workday FML-PL timecode does not send to Workday FML-ABS does send to Workday and deducts flexPTO hours

				Updating a shift to a different timecode (ex: ABS to FML-ABS) will result in three separate rows in Workday for each transaction – the initial book off, the cancellation of the initial book off behind the scenes, and the updated book off. The ultimate PTO deduction is accurate, but you will see all three separate transactions reflected in Workday

This will allow for nuance in scheduling teams where it exists in Workday. 10/25/23 Workday integration time zones will be updated to hopefully correct the 1-day delay of employees coming into VandyWorks and Kronos 11/8/23 Hot Fix for "overlapping" shifts during self-scheduling. This bug has mostly affected procedural areas who schedule Late Stay and evening OCN shifts that are consecutive to WRK shifts. Ex: WRK 08:00-17:00, Late Stay 17:00-19:00. Workaround has been to manually adjust the shifts to start 1 minute later so as not to "overlap"
